- **Idea:** Nerdalize heats houses with computing power. By placing powerful servers in the form of a radiator in people's homes, homes are heated with the heat produced by the servers. This means home owner saves on heating, and companies and researchers using computing power save 30-50% on their computing jobs.





EIT KIC model

A business logic

- **High degree of integration:** each KIC is an independent legal entity, gathering world-class partners from across the knowledge triangle based on a contractual relationship/partnership with the EIT.
- **Long-term strategic approach:** each KIC is set up for a minimum of 7 years to eventually become sustainable.
- **Autonomy and flexibility:** to determine organisational structure and activities governed by a Board of KIC partner organisations.
- **Effective governance:** run by a CEO and a lean management team at central and Co-location Centre level all implementing the Principles of Good Governance.




EIT KIC model

an investment logic

- **Smart funding & high degree of commitment of partners:** EIT funding to KICs is max. 25% of their total budget over time with 75% to be attracted from other sources, both public and private.
- **Culture:** KICs are shaped by strong entrepreneurial mindsets and cultures.
- **The Co-location model:** each KIC consists of world class innovation hotspots leveraging on existing European capacities and building pan-European networks.
- **Results & high impact oriented activities:** KICs implement a Business Plan with measurable deliverables, results and impact.


Overview: contractual relations between the EIT and the KICs

- Based on key principles:



EIT Regional Innovation Scheme (RIS)

Activities:

- Ensuring the flow of both knowledge and people between KICs and selected partnerships
- Integral part of operations and designed by KICs.

Funding

- Selected EIT RIS partnerships will primarily use “other sources” of funding such as national and regional funding

Benefits:

- KICs: influx of talent and ideas
- Selected EIT RIS partnerships: exchanging knowledge and good practices as well as enhancing the regional innovation system
- Individuals: apply and gain knowledge and expertise

- The ARISE programme includes innovation centers from Austria, Czech Republic, Estonia, Greece, Poland, Portugal and Slovenia
- **The objective** is to connect local and regional innovation centres and their ecosystems to EIT Digital's innovation and education ecosystem.
- **The targets** are local ecosystems through Innovation Centers (e.g. Accelerators, Incubators, Regional Clusters) and Students, Universities
- Main ingredients:
 - **Open Hours** for Scale-up companies


KIC Calls for EIT RIS Activities: KIC InnoEnergy - KICStart!
